About the Game

The first form of Roulette was devised in the 18th century in France whereas the mechanism was a hybrid of a gaming wheel invented in 1720 and the Italian game Biribi.

The Roulette wheels used in the Casinos of Paris in the late 1790's had red for the Single Zero and black for the Double Zero. To avoid confusion, the colour green was selected for the Zeros in Roulette wheels starting in the 1800's.



Game Overview

Roulette is a game of chance where players aim to predict the number segment where a ball will land once the wheel stops spinning. There are two main types of roulette wheels: Single Zero Roulette, which has 37 segments numbered 0-36, and Double Zero Roulette, which has 38 segments numbered 00-36.

Every roulette game comes with a house edge, representing the percentage of all bets expected to be kept by the casino over time. The lower the house edge, the greater the proportion of bets returned to players. At Crown Sydney, Single Zero Roulette has a house edge of 2.70%, while Double Zero Roulette has a house edge of 5.26%.

How to Play


- The game begins with players placing their bet/s on the Roulette table until the Dealer announces "No more bets."
- When the ball comes to rest, the Dealer will call out and crown the winning number. The Dealer will then clear losing bets and pay winning bets as per the Payout Odds.

Payout Odds


BET TYPE	DESCRIPTION	PAYOUT ODDS
Straight Up	A bet on any singular number	35 to 1
Split	A bet placed on two numbers	17 to 1
Street	A bet placed on a row of three numbers	11 to 1
Corner	A bet placed covering four numbers	8 to 1
Six-Line	A bet placed on an intersection to cover six numbers	5 to 1
Column	A bet placed to cover a number in a particular column	2 to 1
Dozen	A bet placed to cover numbers 1-12, 13-24 or 25-36	2 to 1
Low	A bet placed to cover numbers 1-18	1 to 1
High	A bet placed to cover numbers 19-36	1 to 1
Even	A bet placed to cover all even numbers	1 to 1
Odd	A bet placed to cover all odd numbers	1 to 1
Red	A bet placed to cover all red numbers on the wheel	1 to 1
Black	A bet placed to cover all black numbers on the wheel	1 to 1
First Five	A bet covering 00-0-1-2-3 (Double Zero Roulette only)	6 to 1


